Graduation Rate In compliance with the Student Right to Know Act, found in Sec. 485(a) of the Higher Education Act of 1965, 34 CFR 668.45

### Graduation Rate Calculation

The rates are calculated based on the Student-Right-to-Know (SRTK) Graduation Rate formula. It is based upon students who entered as full-time, first-time freshmen and graduated within 150% of the length of their program.
