National Aviation Academy of New England, Aviation Maintenance Technology

Based upon the mutual concern for the needs of students pursuing the Aviation Maintenance Technology Program (AMT) and in an effort to provide a continuing articulated program that builds on past learning experience and eliminates unnecessary duplication of instruction, the following are agreements to which we mutually subscribe.

1. Students who have fulfilled the learning outcomes of Middlesex's identified specialty area based on the didactic and clinical coursework required in the National Aviation Academy Aviation Technology Program will be granted credits at Middlesex Community College as follows:

| Graduates of the Aviation Maintenance Technology program with current FAA Mechanic Airframe & Powerplant certification | Will be granted 30 credits of Aviation Maintenance Technology courses (see list below) towards the Aviation Maintenance Technology Associate in Science degree in Liberal Studies |
| Graduate of the program without FAA Certification | Will be granted 30 credits of free electives towards Liberal Studies Associate Degree |

2. To receive credit for the above mentioned Middlesex Community College courses, students must:
 - a. Meet all Middlesex Community College admissions requirements and be a matriculated student in good standing.
 - b. Present an official copy of their National Aviation Academy academic transcript and a copy of their diploma to receive credit.
 - c. Present current FAA Mechanic Airframe & Powerplant certification (a copy will be taken for college records).
