As a part of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF), in accordance with 1800 (a) of the CARES ACT, NAA received funds to provide emergency financial aid grants to students for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus, including eligible expenses under a student's cost of attendance such as food, housing, technology, health care and child care. Students may request funding by answering the questions below. The purpose of this form is to provide you with information regarding the administration of the grants, and to provide you the opportunity to certify eligibility and contact information.

Applicants must meet the general requirements for Federal Financial Aid eligibility in order to receive funding. Please Note: International and DACA students are not eligible for HEERF funding. Students that have a current status of withdrawal are not eligible to receive the grant.

If you have not yet completed a FAFSA to determine eligibility for funds, you may complete a FAFSA at the Federal Student Aid website: <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/afsa>.

Please be advised that this form must be completed in order to receive HEERF funding and must be submitted no later than Monday, May 11th, 2020. Your immediate response is appreciated so that we can process timely.

HEERF funding will be provided to students for expenses related to housing, food, utilities, childcare, transportation, technology, and medical. Any current student who ceases to be an active student (withdraws from the program) is no longer eligible to receive a grant. If an individual ceases to be eligible prior to receiving a grant, any funds that were to be awarded to that individual will be awarded to another student in need. If a student fails to cash their check within 60 days of receiving his/her grant, the award may be cancelled and NAA may distribute the funds to another student in need.

All information is required. Please ensure ALL information is accurate in order to avoid any delay in processing and disbursement of funds.
